#### **PHOTOGRAPHY**

- 1. MOUNTING: to protect prints from damage, all photos must be mounted on a firm backing (poster board) with ½ inch to 1-inch mat border (either black or white only). Frames or glass will NOT be accepted.
- 2. NO UNMOUNTED PHOTOGRAPHS WILL BE ACCEPTED.
- 3. All work must be that of the entrant, other than pictures pre1960 can be someone else, non -

professional.

- 4. All photos must be marked on the back with the entrants name and class entered and on photo paper.
- 5. All print entries must have the top of the photo indicated on the back.
- 6. No computer manipulation except for classes.
- 7. Only 1 entry per class.
- 8. All pictures must be 4x6 or 5x7. Nothing larger.
- 9. All entries submitted by the same exhibitor must be distinctly different from each other.

For example, identical photos/images may not be entered under different classes.

11. **AMATEUR** photographers only. (A professional is any person who earns 50% or more of his/her income from photography)
