- 1. Young Farmers <u>may not</u> show in 4-H classes and must be entered on a Young Farmers Entry Form.
- 2. Young Farmers classes (showmanship & project) will be shown previous to 4-H classes in each section, to enable the organizers to utilize judges that have been contracted to judge 4-H classes.
- 3. Young Farmers <u>must</u> have their own animal and may not use a 4-H members project animal.
- 4. Young Farmers may be stabled in the same building as 4-H animals but stabled at the end of the club display and <u>must</u> be identified as Young Farmers.
